

Knitted star pattern

DK yarn

3.75mm /UK size 9 needles or similar

Abbreviations

K – knit

Kf&b – Knit in the front and back of the same stitch

K2tog – Knit 2 stitches together

Pattern

Cast on 8 stitches leaving enough yarn to sew up seam from centre to edge of star.

* Row 1: Kf&b, K5, K2tog

Row 2-4: K

Repeat last 4 rows twice more (3 times in total)

Row 13: Kf&b, pass the first stitch over the second, cast off the rest of the row until there is only one stitch on the needle.**

Turn work and pick up 7 stitches along the row ends of the point just completed (one for each ridge of the garter stitch) 8 stitches in total.

Knit one row.*

Repeat from * to * 3 more times, then * to ** once.

Fasten off last stitch and cut yarn leaving a long tail to sew two sides of stars together.

Sew up seam from centre to edge of star using the cast on end of yarn.

Make another star in the same way.

Sew four points of the stars together using long cast off ends, stuff lightly then sew up the final point.
